

## Don't Use Any Church Organization For Bible Authority

*All Scriptures from The Old and New King James Versions*

I not saying that all doctrine that is taught at any church is wrong. Most churches teach something correctly found in scriptures. But this is not enough. I am simply saying human reasoning sometimes goes against what the Bible teaches. Always use the Bible as the perfect guide for doctrine. If anything taught contradicts any scripture then the doctrine is wrong. Also, if the Doctrine is so complicated that it is hard to understand, then be careful it could be misteaching. Consider these scriptures:

***Psa 19:7*** *The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul; The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;*

***Psa 119:130*** *The entrance of Your words gives light; It gives understanding to the simple.*

***2Ti 3:16*** *All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.*

If you think all Churches are ok, then consider the following scriptures.

***Rom 16:17*** *Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them. 18 For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.*

***1Co 1:10*** *Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. 11 For it hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them which are of the house of Chloe, that there are contentions among you. 12 Now this I say, that every one of you saith, I am of Paul; and I of Apollos; and I of Cephas; and I of Christ. 13 Is Christ divided? was Paul crucified for you? or were ye baptized in the name of Paul? 14 I thank God that I baptized none of you, but Crispus and Gaius; 15 Lest any should say that I had baptized in mine own name. 16 And I baptized also the household of Stephanas: besides, I know not whether I baptized any other. 17 For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect. 18 For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. 19 For it is written, I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent. 20 Where is the wise? where is the scribe? where is the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? 21 For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. 22 For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom: 23 But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; 24 But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God. 25 Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men. 26 For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: 27 But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to*

confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; 28 And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: 29 That no flesh should glory in his presence. 30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: 31 That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.

1Co 3:3 For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men? 4 For while one saith, I am of Paul; and another, I am of Apollos; are ye not carnal? 5 Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man? 6 I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase. 7 So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase. 8 Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour. 9 For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building. 10 According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon. 11 For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. 12 Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; 13 Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. 14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. 15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire. 16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? 17 If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are. 18 Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise. 19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness. 20 And again, The Lord knoweth the thoughts of the wise, that they are vain. 21 Therefore let no man glory in men. For all things are yours; 22 Whether Paul, or Apollos, or Cephas, or the world, or life, or death, or things present, or things to come; all are yours; 23 And ye are Christ's; and Christ is God's.

Can't you see we can't identify with any false teaching and claim to be following God. If you claim to be of any group or church and find out some teaching is against the Bible teaching, you should not claim to be a part of that group if they won't consider the teaching as error. Always try to change their mind by sound Bible teaching. But if they won't change, then you cannot claim to agree with their Doctrine. You should leave if no one will change the false doctrine. Why? Because that group is associating with false doctrine. If you stay, you will be considered by most people as accepting their teaching.

Maybe it is time to find a church teaching the Bible without contradictions.

Any church that has contradictions to scriptures, then isn't this not the same as claiming "I am of Paul; and another, I am of Apollos; are ye not carnal? ". I am of this group or of another group. Should they be just be of Christ. Should there be any denominations? Should it be only Christ Church?

**Eph 4:3 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. 4 There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; 5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism, 6 One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.**

**Php 1:27 Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;**

**It is true sometimes false teaching arises in a church. The difference is in good churches, the people there are striving to correct all errors, using scripture not men's opinions. The church I attend is trying to worship God's way from all scriptures. Please become a Christian and striving to use all the Bible not just part. Worship God's way according to all scripture. Remember if anything you believe or teach contradicts the Bible, then your belief is wrong and you should not teach it or worship where it is mis taught. It is true initials in any church can disagree on minor things but later with maturity come to a greater understanding. The things which are major are the Doctrines taught in scriptures especially on salvation. Follow the examples of Christ and his Apostils.**
